

## English language proficiency requirements for applying for the FSC's Long-term Scholarship 2017 – 2020 (South-South)

The applicants must provide results of an English language proficiency examination as part of their application. Please see the acceptable tests and the minimum required score in the table below. The applicants are given the opportunity of providing the English certificate latest by 31<sup>st</sup> of December 2017 in case of being accepted for receiving the scholarships.
